The existing Gypsum Wastewater Treatment Plant in the Eagle River Estates neighborhood is approaching capacity. To address this, the Town has collaborated with a designer and construction manager to develop a reconstruction plan. Construction on a new and upgraded Wastewater Treatment Plant began in October 2024.

SCAN ME

The new Wastewater Treatment Plant is designed to accommodate the Town’s projected growth for the next 20 years while meeting the latest regulatory requirements from the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) for effluent discharge. The project is expected to take approximately three years to complete.
