E-BIKES & E-MOTOS

E-BIKE & SCOOTER

Class 1



- **Pedal assist only**
- 20 mph max speed
- Includes electric scooters (less than 750W)
- Allowed on paved bike paths, paved pedestrian paths, and paved recreational trails. Not allowed on soft-surface trails or paths

Class 2



- **Pedal assist & throttle**
- 20 mph max speed
- Allowed on paved bike paths, paved pedestrian paths, and paved recreational trails. Not allowed on soft-surface trails or paths

Class 3



- **Pedal assist only**
- 28 mph max speed
- Speedometer required
- Age 16+ to operate
- Under 18 yrs. old, must wear a helmet
- Not allowed on bicycle paths, pedestrian paths, or recreational paths, whether paved or soft-surfaced, unless path in within a street or highway and/or in a bike lane

E-MOTO



- **Over 750W**
- Driver's License required
- Insurance required
- May not have functional pedals
- Age 16+ to operate
- Under 18 yrs. old, must wear a helmet
- Generally prohibited on sidewalks, bike paths, bike lanes & mountain bike trails

Typically considered Off Highway Vehicles (OHV's), Motor-Driven Cycles or Motorcycles
